# Society For the Study of Egyptian Antiquities

Created in November 1999, the *Montreal Chapter of the Society for the Study of Egyptian Antiquities* (SSEA) originates from the Head Office Society in Toronto. The SSEA is the only Egyptological scientific organization in Canada. It is a charitable organization founded in 1969 and duly incorporated the 10<sup>th</sup> of August 1970 under the laws of the province of Ontario. The Society was founded to stimulate interest in Egyptology, to assist those interested – professionals and non-professionals alike – with research and training in the field, and to sponsor and promote archaeological expeditions to Egypt.

In 1980, the Society established the Canadian Institute in Egypt, and on January 1, 1981, the Society and its Institute became an affiliate of the *Canadian Mediterranean Institute*. In September 1982 an official protocol was signed between Egypt and Canada which established the Institute as an official cultural presence in Egypt at its premises in Cairo. In 1984, a new Chapter of the SSEA was created in Calgary and in 2000 the Montreal Chapter is established. Toronto founded their own chapter in 2007, as well as Vancouver in 2010.

Logistical and secretarial services are provided to scholars engaged in research associated with Egypt and the Sudan. The Society has carried out an epigraphic and archaeological survey of Osiris Ruler of Eternity at Karnak in Upper Egypt, and has been an active sponsor of the Dakhleh Oasis Project, in addition to providing support for many other research expeditions including the University of Toronto's *Wadi Tumilat Project*.

Since January 2002, the *Montreal Chapter* is very proud to have nominated Dr. Bernard Mathieu, former Director of the Institut Français d'Archéologie Orientale (IFAO), as an honorary member.

To promote public interest in Egyptology, the Society instituted a public lecture series and mini-lectures for members. The Society also publishes the *Journal of the Society for the Study of Egyptian Antiquities* (JSSEA), a national Newsletter and a regional bulletin *L'Escribe* for members.
